"BEIT FURTHER CRDAINED that when such a permit is issued, it shall limit the amplification so that it will not interfere with the peace, tranquility, order, comfort, convenience, safety and welfare of the residents of the said Town; it shall be for a specific location where traffic hazards will not occur; and that separate permits shall be obtained for each date and time of use of such a system.

"Anyone found guilty of violating this ordinance shall be fined not more than \$100 (one hundred dollars) or imprisoned for not more than 30 (thirty) days, or both."

Motion carried unanimously.

Final wording of the Zoning Ordinance, Town of Clifton, was read, see copy attached hereto. It was moved and seconded that this ordinance in final form be enacted into law. Motion carried unanimously.

It was moved and seconded that Paul Longerbeam be appointed to be in charge of the Department of Permits and Inspections of the Town of Clifton. Motion carried unanimously.
