• Councilmember Milne moved to approve the recommendations of the Planning Commission as set forth in its April 24th report, seconded by Councilmember McDonald. The motion was approved by poll vote, 4-0.

b. Architectural Review Board.

The ARB requested that a letter be sent from the Town to the Bennetts regarding the unpermitted structure on their property, and also offered to provide guidance to the residents on how to retro-fit the structure for the purpose of receiving a COA.

- Councilmember Milne moved to authorize Councilmember Poe to speak with the Bennetts to help them submit an application to the ARB, and to report on their progress at the next Town Council meeting, seconded by Councilmember Poe. The motion was approved by poll vote, 4-0.
- Councilmember Nickum moved to place the discussion of code violations on the agenda for the next Town Council meeting, seconded by Councilmember Poe. The motion was approved by poll vote, 4-0.

Royce Jarrendt said that the ARB will provide a list of known Code violations to the Council at the next meeting.

- c. Other Committees:
 - i. Special Projects Committee Streetscape Phase II

Councilmember McDonald reported on the need for the Town to hold a Public Information Meeting in order to update everyone on the project's progress and current design concepts. He recommended that 30 minutes would be needed for the public to view the exhibits, followed by additional time for a presentation and Q&A session. The Council discussed starting prior to the usual time of 7:30 PM, in order to accommodate the Information Meeting.

- Councilmember McDonald moved to set the beginning of the Public Information Meeting at 7:00 PM, with the first 30 minutes set aside for public review of exhibits, with the Regular Meeting to follow directly after the presentation and Q&A session, seconded by Councilmember Nickum. The motion was approved by poll vote, 4-0.
- Councilmember Nickum moved to add the approval of the proposed FY19 Budget, as advertised, to the next month's Agenda, seconded by Councilmember McDonald. The motion was approved by poll vote, 4-0.
- ii. Committee on the Environment Update on Earth Day Clean-Up and Upcoming Events.

Laura McDonald reported on the success of the clean-up event, which was covered on page 2 of the Connection Newspaper. She noted that there was good turn-out for the event, and that the Girl Scouts worked to plant a large quantity of bluebells.

The next COTE events are Pollinator Week (June 18-24), followed by The Great Sunflower Project (planting sunflowers and counting honeybees). The Great American Camp-out (in partnership with the CBA) is scheduled for July 21st. Finally, several presentations are in the planning stage for next winter.

Attached are the **Financial Reports for the period ended April 30, 2018**. The Financial Reports include:

- The Summary of Cash Balances Report as of April 30, 2018 reflects total funds of \$1,203,726.54. The Town's Certificates of Deposit totaling \$610,392.88 with John Marshall Bank matured on March 19, 2018. The Treasurer met and talked with John Marshall Bank and United Bank who recommended their best offers for reinvesting the Town's funds. As approved at the March Town Council meeting, \$400,000 plus \$771 interest was withdrawn from John Marshall Bank and deposited into United Bank on March 19, 2018. United Bank has issued four \$100,000, 2-year CDs to earn 2% APR (up from 1.19%). John Marshall Bank renewed the other two CDs for \$105,000 each plus \$107 interest for 18months @ 1.56% APR (up from 1.19%). See the detailed Cash Balance Report.
- Profit & Loss Summary by Fund for period ended 04/30/2018. Highlights of April transactions are noted on this summary report. The main items for the month include:
- Clifton Film Festival: Receipt of \$3,376.23 for proceeds from the Film Festival. See the supplemental Film Festival Report.
- Pink House Rental: Tim Hugo exercised his option to extend his lease for 2 years to
 December 2019 @ \$1,300 per month. The April report reflects an additional \$1,200 bringing
 the rental income up-to-date.
- Taxes & Permits highlights include receipt in April of \$314.91 in BPOLs for April –
 totaling \$41,988.47 for FY18 YTD, \$425 was received for ARB fees, \$66.91 was received
 in April for new Motor Vehicle Fees from Fairfax County, for a YTD total of \$9,521; 27%
 greater than FY17 for the same period. \$2,355.23 was received in April from Fairfax
 County for Feb. 2018 Local Sales Taxes, reflecting the usual two-month delay in Sales
 tax revenues.
- Contractual Expense: The highlights for April include \$450 expended for C.H. Cleaning; \$501.71 expended for Community Hall electricity (down from \$755 in March), \$2,337.50 for Planning Commission general consulting (offset by payment by owners), and \$1,033 for Town Parks Committee expenses.
- CIF CIF Special Project Streetscape Phase 2 April activity reflects a payment to J2
 Engineering in the amount of \$1,085.60; \$19,799 was expended for the paving of the
 RR Siding Parking Facility project as approved by the Town Council, bringing the YTD
 CIF expenditures to \$50,559.
- Supplemental Detail Reports are provided as follows:
- Clifton Film Festival Report Net proceeds for the event are \$2,996.57 as of April 30th.
- Community Hall Comparative Report
- **Profit & Loss Detail Export** Report for period ended 04/30/2018. This report is a detailed export of the income and expenses from the accounting system. Notes and supplementary

schedules are provided on the Profit & Loss Summary report and as additional tabs which highlight items of interest.

Other updates:

- The due date for filing BPOL Applications and payments was be March 1st. \$24,095.84 was received in March and \$314.91 was received in April. This reflects a total of \$32,124.89 for 2018 receipts from 45 businesses 82%. FY18 total received to date: \$41,998 represents 70% of the \$46,000 total budgeted.
- An addition VISA credit card in the name of the Town of Clifton, Amanda Christman, Clerk, was initiated with a credit limit of \$500 as authorized by Mayor Hollaway and the Town Council at the January meeting. The new card was mailed directly to the Clerk.
- Final Bound Audited Financial Statements for FY17, ended 6/30/17, were received and are being distributed at the meeting. The electronic copies will be emailed to you within a few days.
- The public hearing for the FY19 Proposed Budget will be held prior to the May 8th Regular Town Council Meeting. The budget will be approved at the June 6th Town Council meeting.

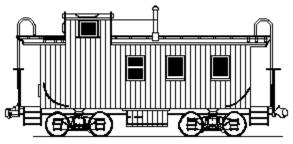
